1. BRING YOUR CROP SENSOR CAMERA BODY

If you have a crop sensor camera, bring it as it offers you a closer look at your subject.



2. TRY DIFFERENT ANGLES AND PERSPECTIVES

Trying something different allows you to capture the subject in unique ways.



3. USE NATURAL LIGHT TO IMPROVE YOUR PHOTOS

Natural light offers your scene an atmospheric look with golden hues and tones.



4. RESPECT THE ANIMALS AND ENVIRONMENT

Respect the subjects you are shooting. This ensures a minimum impact on their environment.



5. LEAVE NOTHING BEHIND

Remember where you are and don't leave anything that doesn't belong there.



6. WHAT KIND OF GEAR DO YOU NEED

A camera bag, with batteries and memory cards is a must. So is a tripod, gloves and tough shoes.



7. BUT DON'T THINK YOU MUST HAVE A DSLR...

Ensure that everything in your frame fits the subject you are shooting – keep it all natural.



8. KEEP EVERYTHING IN THE FRAME

9. LEARN ABOUT THE SUBJECTS YOU'RE SHOOTING

Knowing about the subjects you are shooting allows you a glimpse into their habits.



10. CROP CLOSE ON TEXTURES

Get in closer and fill the frame with subjects that present textures, shapes and form.



11. HOW TO SEPARATE THE SUBJECT FROM THE BACKGROUND

Add some distance between the foreground and the background to separate them.



12. WHAT LENSES DO YOU NEED FOR NATURE

A zoom lens, with a long focal length and fairly wide aperture might be a good place to start.
